October Sales Tax Revenue Short of Budget

The City of Springfield's October 2012 one-percent general sales tax check from the Missouri Department of Revenue is down compared to budget. Budgeted revenue for October was \$3,519,000 and the actual receipts were \$3,152,954.

Year-to-date, the budget is \$13,685,000, and actual receipts are \$12,884,335. On a year-to-date basis, that puts the City down \$800,665 or 5.85% below budget.
